








# REGISTRATION & START LOCATION




Registration, staging, and start/ finish all happen near the **Bobcat Cove Trail Head** on the northwest side of the lake.

# **MORE DETAILS**

### **OBRA-sanctioned event**

This is an OBRA sanctioned event. Annual or one-day memberships are required. Register for membership online at **obra.org**.

Onsite registration will be available - Cash and Venmo only.

#### **Race rules**

OBRA numbers pinned on your RIGHT side.

Riders must stay to the right of the center line for the entirety of the race. Riders will be given the entire road for their finishes in the final 200 meters.

There will be a lead and follow car for all categories. Once outside of this enclosure, riders are expected to follow the rules of the road.

During your warmup, please be conscious of ongoing races and avoid the finish line.

## Parking

Each car will need to pay a fee of \$7 when entering the park. There will be parking at C ramp (see above). Please be conscious of other park users by not blocking ramps for boats.

## **PNW Cup**

The Pacific Northwest (PNW) Cup is a new race series that hopes to crown a PNW Road Race Champion across **OBRA** and **WSBA** road races.

There are 4 events in the series, and the champion must compete in 3 of 4 races to be eligible. Leaders jerseys will be awarded in the following categories:

#### Women Fields:

- · 1/2
- 3 (if the 3's are combined with another field and scored separately, results will only count towards PNW cup if they race with the 1/2s
  4/5
- Men (or Open) Fields:
  - · 1/2
  - 3
  - 4/5
- Masters
  - · 40+ 1/2/3
  - 50+ 3/4/5
  - 60+ Open
- Non-Binary Open
